Earnest Brew Works, a brewer-owned and operated brewery and taproom, will host the event at two locations, Westgate & South Toledo, from 4 pm to 8 pm. Attendees can enjoy a variety of pies and beers (non-alcoholic beverages available), all while supporting a great cause.

Tickets are **not** required. Anyone can stop by and grab a slice of pie and a beer for \$10. Some whole, homemade pies will be available for purchase at the event or can be preordered on the Mobile Meals website beginning February 15th. You can take a whole pie home for the entire family or eat it there. Mobile Meals hopes to reach their fundraising goal of \$10,000! All proceeds benefit Mobile Meals of Toledo.

Pi Day is an annual celebration of the mathematical constant π (pi). Pi Day is observed on March 14 since 3, 1, and 4 are the first three significant figures of π . It was founded in 1988 by Larry Shaw, an employee of the San Francisco science museum, the Exploratorium. Celebrations often involve eating pie or holding pi recitation competitions.

Mobile Meals of Toledo helps those needing assistance with diet and meal preparation, regardless of income, so they can remain in their homes and retain the dignity and independence they cherish.
