It's been a year since I accepted the role of CEO at Mobile Meals of Toledo, and I've been so appreciative of the warm welcome from the staff, the board of directors, and the entire community. I quickly came to realize how fortunate we are to have such a dedicated and compassionate group of volunteers and donors who have wholeheartedly supported this organization's mission for more than five decades.

Together, we have accomplished significant achievements in the past year, such as expanding our meal delivery services by 5,415 meals and supporting 400 more residents in 2023, providing a broader range of meal options, adding more congregate meal sites, and reaching even more older adults and individuals with medical needs.

Now, we have an exciting opportunity to expand our impact further and reach an even larger number of seniors in need. Over the next decade, our goal is to enhance access to under-served communities, offer a wider variety of meal options that cater to our clients' health and cultural requests, introduce programs to address social isolation and loneliness, and bolster our organization for long-term

sustainability. We are enthusiastic about the possibilities outlined in our new strategic plan and relying on the support of our volunteers and donors to bring this to fruition. In 2025, our projected budget will surpass \$2,300,000 to uphold and enhance our current level of service. Looking ahead to 2030, we estimate this amount to exceed \$5,000,000. While these figures may seem substantial, we are fortunate to have a committed team of employees, a fiscally responsible board, exceptional volunteers, and generous donors backing our mission - like YOU. We are eager to embark on this journey and hope we can rely on your support.

From Our Local Kitchen

The Mobile Meals kitchen is consistently working to enhance our menus and expand the offerings for our clients. This year, we added Meatless Mondays. This new addition to our regular low-sodium/low-fat menu gives our clients another option for healthier eating for those monitoring the amount of red meat in their diets.

Along with this new offering, Mobile Meals provides medically tailored menus created to meet the specific dietary needs of our clients with health conditions such as diabetes and renal issues and those requiring mechanical



or pureed diets. These menus are essential for seniors and individuals who are medically vulnerable or living with chronic health conditions.

Mobile Meals has recently partnered with Anne Grady Services to assist individuals with developmental disabilities. Participants in this program receive specially prepared meals that are finely chopped to aid those who struggle with swallowing, a condition known as dysphagia. As many individuals with developmental disabilities age, swallowing challenges can become more significant,



necessitating this critical adjustment to their diet, making eating safer and more manageable. Paying particular attention to the texture and viscosity of the food is essential in ensuring they can safely enjoy their meals.

At Mobile Meals, we are committed to offering customized services that focus on health and overall wellness. We believe that everyone, regardless of their health conditions, should have access to delicious, nutritious meals that meet their dietary needs.

"Sir James is quite a local celebrity; he travels with me and wins the hearts of everyone we meet."




