Starting Monday, September 8th, Mobile Meals of Toledo is launching a new partnership with MemoryLane Care Services in Toledo, providing hot, nutritious meals to participants in their Adult Day Service Program, Monday through Friday.

MemoryLane Care Services offers compassionate care, support, and companionship for older adults, especially those living with dementia, who need assistance and supervision during the day. This collaboration ensures that 30-40 participants will receive meals tailored to their specific dietary needs, including options for those with diabetes, renal disease, and those who require mechanical or pureed food.


This partnership was born out of a meeting of COPE (Coalition of Organizations Protecting Elders), a network of over 100 agencies working together to address elder abuse and support aging adults in our community. It was at a COPE meeting that Mobile Meals met with Social Services Director.




Mid-Year 2025 Service Summary
